SCIENCE	<p>Children should learn: the difference between a tree, flower and plant.</p> <p>TEAMS Lesson</p>	<p>Please only complete the pages identified.</p> <p>Key Stage Science Study Book Year 1 Read pages 10 and 11. Answer questions pages 11.</p> <p>Watch lesson 1 How do I plant a bean? https://classroom.thenational.academy/lessons/how-do-i-plant-a-bean-cgwp6e and complete online activities and quiz.</p> <p>Task - Look around your garden or local area. What types of plants can you find? Draw a picture of the plants you see.</p>
RE	<p>Children should learn: the meaning of forgiveness.</p> <p>TEAMS Lesson</p>	<p>Explain that this half term value is forgiveness. Which means saying sorry and letting go of bad feelings. Have you ever had to say sorry? Is it hard to say or easy? How did it feel? What had you done? Has someone ever had to say sorry to you for something they had done?</p> <p>Task – write down when you have had to say sorry to someone. What did you do? How did it feel? Was it difficult or easy to say?</p>
HISTORY	<p>Children should learn: Where London is and what it is like.</p> <p>TEAMS Lesson</p>	<p>Recap the four countries of the United Kingdom and the capital cities on google maps. Watch Transport, travel and landmarks of London: https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/class-clips-video/geography-ks1-ks2-transport-travel-and-landmarks-of-london/zhttscw Show chn the map of London with the landmarks – something that is easily seen and recognised. What landmarks can you see? Use the key provided.</p> <p>Task – chn draw a picture of a London landmark and label what it is.</p>
GEOGRAPHY	<p>Children should learn: Physical and human features.</p> <p>TEAMS Lesson</p>	<p>Watch what are physical and human features: https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zqj3n9q/articles/zr8q7nb and play interactive game. Look at powerpoint: physical and human features are things that you can see all around you. Physical features are natural and would always be around without people. Human features are things that have been built by people.</p> <p>Task – Look around local area. What human and physical features can you see? Draw a picture and label what you find.</p>

ART	Children should learn: Draw a tree, plant or flower. Think about the parts of a plant.	Draw or paint a picture of a plant, tree or flower you see in your garden, house or around your local area.
